## **Session Objective**

As per each ICANN public meeting, the GAC devotes time on its schedule to capacity development matters. For ICANN84, two sessions will focus on the New gTLD Program Next Round, and a third one will be dedicated to discussions of high interest to the committee on Emerging Technologies, followed by a presentation on the Generic Names Supporting Organisation (GNSO) Policy Development Process (PDP).

#### **Background**

GAC capacity development sessions (CDS) are built to provide an opportunity for GAC members to learn the basics or increase their knowledge on aspects of the ICANN multistakeholder model, its structure, and operations. It is also an opportunity for GAC attendees to become acquainted with different ICANN community groups in order to facilitate future dialogue, and to share experiences and best practices to enhance GAC internal collaboration on various ICANN matters.

In light of the high engagement demonstrated by members, the USRWG and the GAC Leadership continue exploring new modalities to enhance capacity development initiatives intersessionally and at ICANN meetings.

## **Current Status and Recent Developments**

For 2025 and 2026, capacity development activities of the GAC will mainly focus on topics related to the New gTLD Program Next Round. The objective is to raise the GAC's awareness on the different issues and processes, to help GAC delegates prepare for the next round. Additional capacity development sessions on issues that the committee wishes to discuss in plenary, can be added to the ICANN Meeting GAC schedule, upon consideration by the GAC Leadership.
