

CCWG-Accountability & Human rights

- Third Draft Proposal: Recommendation #6: out its mission. Bylaw language+ transitional bylaw internationally recognized Human Rights as it carries Reaffirming ICANN's Commitment to respect
- tight Public comments: no framework for interpretation, risk of litigation, risk of IPR, deadline for WS2 is too
- Final report: consensus language.
