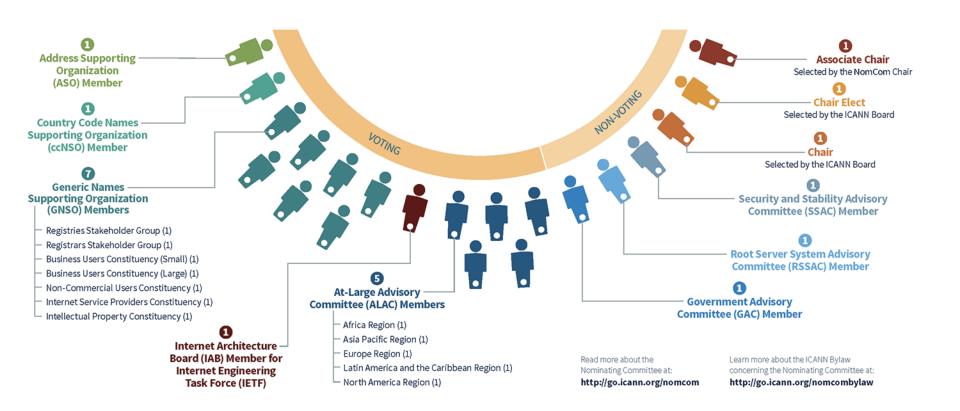
What is the Nomcom?

Group responsible for selecting candidates for ICANN leadership roles:

- Board: 8 members (half of the ICANN Board)
- GNSO: 3 members
- ccNSO: 3 members
- ALAC: 3 members

- 7 GNSO
- 5 ALAC
- 1 ccNSO
- 1 ASO
- 1 IAB(IETF)

3 non-voting members

- 1 GAC (non voting)
 No GAC rep appointed
- 1 SSAC
- 1 RSSAC

- 1 non-voting Chair
- 1 non-voting Chair-elect
- 1 non-voting Associate Chair

Existing and possible Scenarios for GAC Participation in NomCom

- Status Quo: Retain one non-voting position but do not fill it pending further developments.
- What was done: Submit GAC-agreed criteria to the NomCom

To be reviewed:

- Fill the vacant position but limit it to simple reporting
- Fill the vacant position and actively apply GAC-agreed criteria

GAC-agreed criteria sent to the NomCom

- The personal qualities and experience identified by the ICANN Board in its advice to the NomCom of March 2017
- Experience of working with or in the public sector, including national or local government, public authorities or intergovernmental bodies
- An understanding and appreciation of advancing the public interest through building partnerships and consensus
- Experience in the multicultural setting and understanding of the value and importance of diversity for ICANN as a global coordinator of the Domain Name System
