

### **About the GAC - History and Committee Role**


- The voice of Governments and Intergovernmental Organizations (IGOs) in ICANN's multi-stakeholder structure
- First Meeting March 1999 (25th anniversary at ICANN79)
- Key Roles of the Committee:
  - Provide advice to the ICANN Board <u>per ICANN Board request or on its own initiative</u>
  - Provide input and advice on issues of public policy, <u>especially where there may be</u> <u>interaction between ICANN's activities or policies and national laws or international</u> <u>agreements</u>
- Input from government perspective on ICANN operational matters

### **GAC Working Methods - Operating Principles**

- GAC manages its own set of Operating Principles (51)
   <a href="https://gac.icann.org/operating-principles/operating-principles-june-2017">https://gac.icann.org/operating-principles/operating-principles-june-2017</a>
- GAC Operating Principles address operational topics such membership, meeting practices, working methods, elections, etc.
- GAC Operating Principles tend to be general in nature (flexibility)
- GAC Operating Principles are evolving, dynamic, and responsive:
  - Amended in Buenos Aires in 2015 to allow for 5 Vice Chairs
  - Amended in Johannesburg on June, 2017 to allow for electronic voting
  - Current principles are under review by a standing committee working group (GOPE WG)

### **GAC Working Methods - Committee Work Products**

The GAC provides advice and information to the ICANN Board and community through "communiqués", numerous community public comments and many pieces of direct correspondence.

- 81 Communiqués to the ICANN Board
- Public Comments in response to Requests for Comment (RFCs)
- Letters to Board and other ICANN communities
- Board-GAC Interaction Group (BGIG) exchanges
- Policy Develop Process (PDP) documents and support (GNSO, ccNSO)

**GAC Under-Served Regions WG (USRWG)** - Focuses on regions under-served by the DNS industry, and least developed economies and small island developing states.

### **GAC Working Methods - GAC and the ICANN Board**

- The GAC has a unique relationship with the ICANN Board, created through the ICANN Bylaws. The ICANN Board takes the GAC's advice into account through a structured process.
- The GAC's Communique to the Board, provided at the end of GAC Meetings reflects one (the most common) application of this structured process.
- The GAC leadership often acts as the liaison between the GAC and the ICANN Board, the ICANN organization, other Advisory Committees (ACs) and Supporting Organizations (SOs), and other relevant stakeholders.
- Board-GAC Interaction Group (BGIG) Was formed to optimize the relationship between the Board and the GAC. It has also been used by the Board to enable the process for receipt, consideration, processing and tracking of GAC advice and Issues of Importance.

#### **GAC Role in ICANN - Advice to the Board**


"Bylaws Section 12.2(a)(x): The advice of the Governmental Advisory Committee on public policy matters shall be duly taken into account, both in the formulation and adoption of policies. In the event that the Board determines to take an action that is not consistent with Governmental Advisory Committee advice, it shall so inform the Governmental Advisory Committee and state the reasons why it decided not to follow that advice.

Any Governmental Advisory Committee advice approved by a full Governmental Advisory Committee consensus, understood to mean the practice of adopting decisions by general agreement in the absence of any formal objection ("GAC Consensus Advice"), may only be rejected by a vote of no less than 60% of the Board, and the Governmental Advisory Committee and the Board will then try, in good faith and in a timely and efficient manner, to find a mutually acceptable solution. The Governmental Advisory Committee will state whether any advice it gives to the Board is GAC Consensus Advice."



#### **GAC Membership**


GAC membership criteria is established in Article IV of the GAC Operating Principles, which also specifies criteria each member's accredited representatives and advisers.


#### **Strategic & Annual Planning**

  - o 4) DNS Abuse
  - 5) Domain Name Registration
  - o 6) Universal Acceptance
  - 7) Impact of New Technology on Internet Unique Identifier Systems
  - 8) Internet Governance
  - 9) Internet Number Resources
- The GAC has also created an <u>Annual 2024-25 work plan</u> to direct its resources
- Among the nine strategic priorities, 58 "Expected Outcomes" have been identified in the annual plan
- GAC Leadership Team will be reporting regularly on progress and is developing a "tracking" document for future/regular committee reference
