EPDP & IRT Update and Priorities

- The RySG welcomed the conclusion of Phase I of the EPDP and continues to actively engage in Phase II.
- The RySG continues to work towards a system for responsible data disclosure that balances the needs of Contracted Parties and key stakeholders, such as law enforcement.
- EPDP Phase II continues to work on the building blocks of a standardized access model (SSAD) including defining groups of users, defining a central or decentralized model, and assigning liability.
- The RySG is also involved in the IRT to develop a Consensus Policy from the EPDP Phase I Final Report Recommendations.
- The IRT has requested an extension from the GNSO to ensure sufficient time for public comment and review. The IRT will meet during ICANN 66.
