2. b. i. Assessment of GAC ICANN69 Meeting (successes and future improvements)

Meeting Considerations:

- Meeting length:
 - Does the GAC want a shorter meeting in terms of days or a longer one with less meeting hours?
 - There have generally been fewer GAC sessions at ICANN “virtual” Meetings but not less intersessional work - how does the GAC feel about this? Is it better or worse?
 - Concentrated working hours but short (one week) or more relaxed working hours over a longer period of time (two weeks)
 - Other topics/comments/suggestions?
- Meeting time:
 - Time zone - Is adapting to the host country time zone fair? (rotating time zone (share the pain)
 - At a fixed block of hours relatively reasonable to everyone?
 - Other topics/comments/suggestions?

2. b. i. Assessment of GAC ICANN69 Meeting (cont.- 2 of 3)

GAC Communique Considerations:

- Communique substance:
 - Continue without advice - leaving advice to intersessional opportunities through exchange of correspondence?
 - Start thinking of how to include GAC Advice in Communique given that the current “virtual” situation may be continuing for some time?
 - Other topics/comments/suggestions?
- Communique process:
 - Good to continue with the current process (48-hour review after finalization)?
 - Other topics/comments/suggestions?



2. b. i. Assessment of GAC ICANN69 Meeting (cont. - 3 of 3)

General GAC Work Load/ Pace:

- Continued general ICANN Community concerns regarding work pace - reconsider in order to maintain the level of community volunteers and avoid participant “burn-out”.
- For GAC, Work Load/Pace seems to be decreasing during meeting week but increasing intersessionally, does this:
 - Suit GAC members?
 - Not suit GAC members?
- Other topics, comments, suggestions?

2. b. ii. Ideas/Plans For GAC ICANN70 - Community Forum

- Any GAC anticipated topics this far in advance for March 2021?
 - Capacity-building session for Human Rights Core Value (suggestion arising from session 3)
- Format
 - Should GAC take advantage of additional community “work” weeks or stick to traditional meeting week?
 - Continue to generally “time-shift” bilateral meetings with other ICANN communities? (e.g., ccNSO, GNSO)
- Other topics, comments, suggestions?
