2020 GAC Leadership Election Results

- The 2020 GAC Leadership Election Nomination period closed on 2 September with a total of five (5) leadership nominations from GAC Members.
- One (1) nomination for GAC Chair was received and four (4) nominations for GAC Vice Chair were received.
- Based on the terms of the GAC Operating Principles, all nominated candidates can be seated without a balloting process.
- The five nominees, and their positions, are as follows:
 - 2020 GAC Chair Nominee – Manal Ismail (Egypt)
 - 2020 GAC Vice Chair Nominee - Jorge Cancio (Switzerland)
 - 2020 GAC Vice Chair Nominee - Par Brumark (Niue)
 - 2020 GAC Vice Chair Nominee – Pua Hunter (Cook Islands)
 - 2020 GAC Vice Chair Nominee – Rodrigue Guiguemde (Burkina Faso)
- Since there were fewer nominees than positions, no balloting period was required for this calendar year election. The nominees will officially begin their terms at the end of the ICANN70 meeting in March 2021.
