


#### 4. Tour de Table




#### **Recent Innovations**

- **Communique Pre-Meeting Preparation Phase** prior to meeting week (contribution received already for ICANN76)
- **Communiqué "touch point" at end of every GAC plenary session** (i.e., "is there an issue of importance or matter of potential GAC Advice stemming from this topic discussion today"?)
- Heightened attention to editing efforts by contributors edits processed by support staff to ensure appropriate tracking of contributions
- Continued 72-hour review period (so far, post-meeting process not needed)
