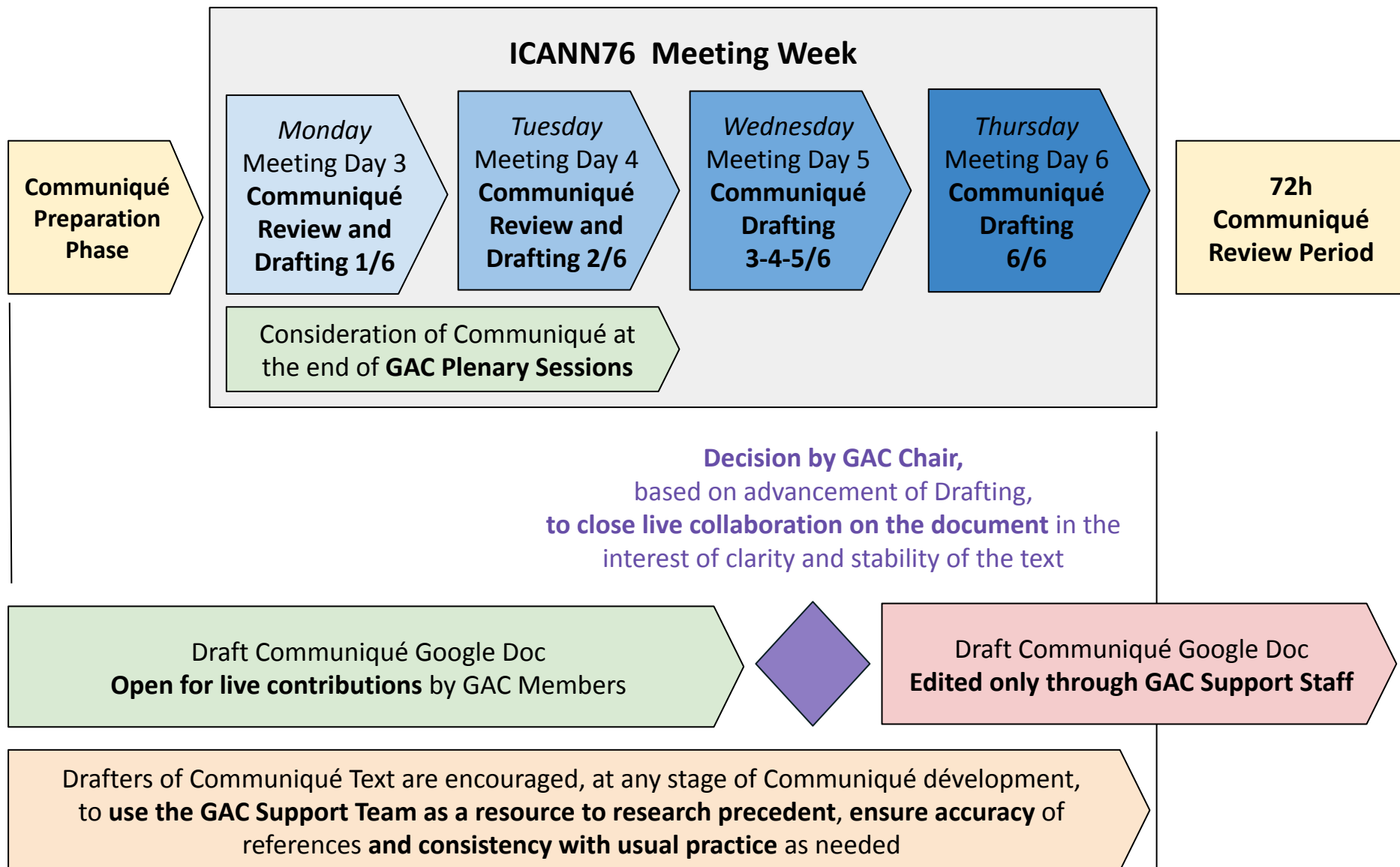
4. Tour de Table

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Recent Innovations

- **Communique Pre-Meeting Preparation Phase** - prior to meeting week (contribution received already for ICANN76)
- **Commiqué “touch point” at end of every GAC plenary session** (i.e., “is there an issue of importance or matter of potential GAC Advice stemming from this topic discussion today”?)
- **Heightened attention to editing efforts** by contributors - edits processed by support staff to ensure appropriate tracking of contributions
- **Continued 72-hour review period** (so far, post-meeting process not needed)
