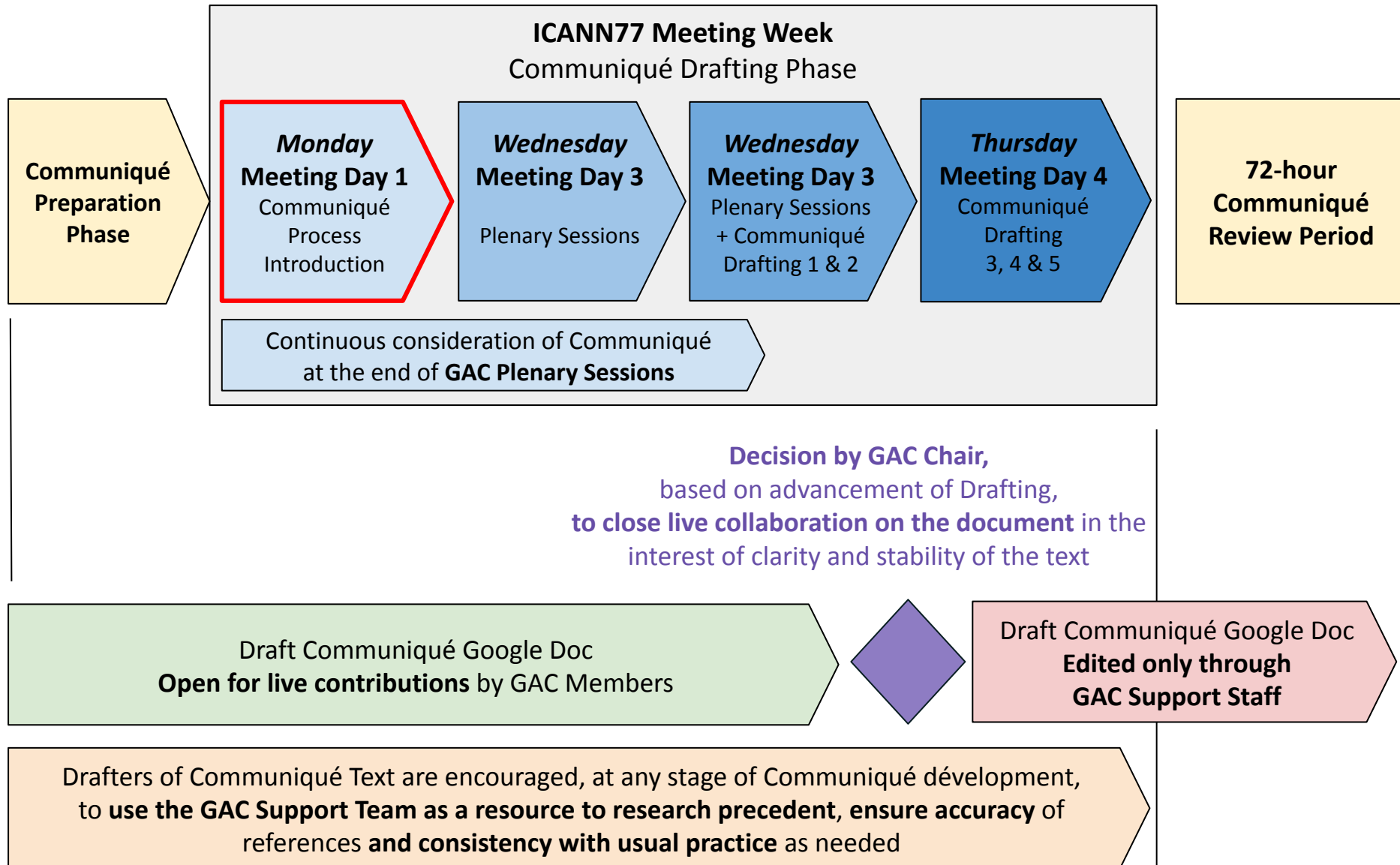


4. Tour de Table

Recent Innovations

- **Communique Pre-Meeting Preparation Phase** - prior to meeting week (contributions received already for ICANN77)
- **Communique “touch point” at end of every GAC plenary session** (i.e., “is there an issue of importance or matter of potential GAC Advice stemming from this topic discussion today”?)
- **Heightened attention to editing efforts** by contributors - edits processed by support staff to ensure appropriate tracking of contributions
- **Continued 72-hour review period** (so far, post-meeting process not used)

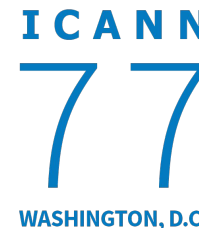
- a. **GAC Community Interaction ([SO-AC Chairs](#), BGIG, etc.)**
- Community Leadership (SO-AC leaders) meet regularly before ICANN public meetings to review matters of cross-community impact
 - Topics of recent SO-AC Chair Roundtables have included:
 - Community Priority Topics for the Coming Year; and
 - Board-Community engagement at ICANN Public Meetings
 - Community Chairs also make their own monthly call opportunities to share information, convey community priorities and identify areas of common interest



6. Notable Developments Since ICANN76

b. GAC Community Interaction (SO-AC Chairs, [BGIG](#), etc.)

- The Board GAC Interaction Group (BGIG) includes a subset of Board Members and interested GAC Members.
- The BGIG has proven to be an effective venue for discussions to ensure effective Board and GAC collaboration and communication
- Board Scorecard on GAC Advice from ICANN76 Communique - approved by Board in mid-May.
- Board Scorecard on GAC Issues of Importance just shared by Board last week with discussion last week (6 June)
- BGIG Membership open to any interested GAC representative - please contact gac-staff@icann.org
