Policy Gap Analysis



Policy Gap Analysis Update: Background on the work

- 1. LB case highlighted a potential gap in the global policy framework (June 2023)
- 2. Ad-hoc group of ccNSO Council members established after ICANN 77
- 3. Agreed at ICANN 80 in Kigali that a more formal, transparent structure needed
- 4. Policy Gaps Analysis Working Group formed (August 2024) to:
 - a. Prepare an overview of policies and guidance related to ccTLDs;
 - b. Identify possible gaps in current policy/guidance/practices;
 - c. Advise ccNSO Council whether to act (and if so how) on any gaps identified.

Gap Analysis

- Working group consideration concluded last week
- Recommendation is for two ccNSO Study Groups, to look in depth at:
 - IANA Public Records for ccTLDs what is the purpose, data accuracy and maintenance
 - IANA role (if any) in disaster recovery for ccTLDs.
- ccNSO Council will decide on the next steps in the next few months.






Number of Employees




Diversity by numbers - ccNSO Membership






Diversity by numbers - Governance Models
