A) Notable Agenda Highlights

- ICANN82 - “Community Forum” - meeting format
- GAC Priority policy topic sessions - (New gTLD Next Round issues, DNS Abuse, Registration Data, etc.)

- Proposed Leadership Elections and Term Limit Changes
- Bilateral Community relations (throughout the Week)
- Communique drafting (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday)

- Notable for **In-person** Attendees

B) Membership Attendance at ICANN Meetings

Challenges - Membership Attendance:

- Resource intensive for staff to capture participation metrics at ICANN Meetings by publication of the Communique & formal minutes
- Several remote participants of delegations are **NOT** registering for the meeting thus impacting accurate attendance data

Prior Attempts:



Pad & pen passed around but risked improper processing of personal data



iPad with email check-in but was clunky and members entered email addresses not used for meeting registration thus difficult to reconcile to membership



Planned attempts at badge scanning, but either costly with scanners or processed data well beyond purpose

Active Check-In Solution (Pilot):

- Focus: take attendance at **delegate** level thus providing attendance at Member & Observer level
- CES re-established as **authority** for GAC membership data
- Establish **new rule**:
 - All delegates **MUST** register for ICANN Meetings or risk their delegation not being recognized
- Setup a single but active virtual **check-in** beyond registration as a prototype to test solution efficacy
- **Daily** posting of delegation check-in
- Communicate before and during ICANN Meeting


Benefits:

- Reduced resources and increased focus of substance of issues
- Shared responsibility of demonstrating participation
- Faster & more accurate attendance for communique & reports



Schedule for ICANN82 (Pilot):

07 **Prepare Data:** staff data preparation to reconcile current membership against meeting registration data

08 **Announce, Send & Post**
 **Opening Plenary:** provide verbal reminder of check-in prototype solution and for delegates to submit



@ end-of-day, reconcile data & email participation survey to all registered delegates

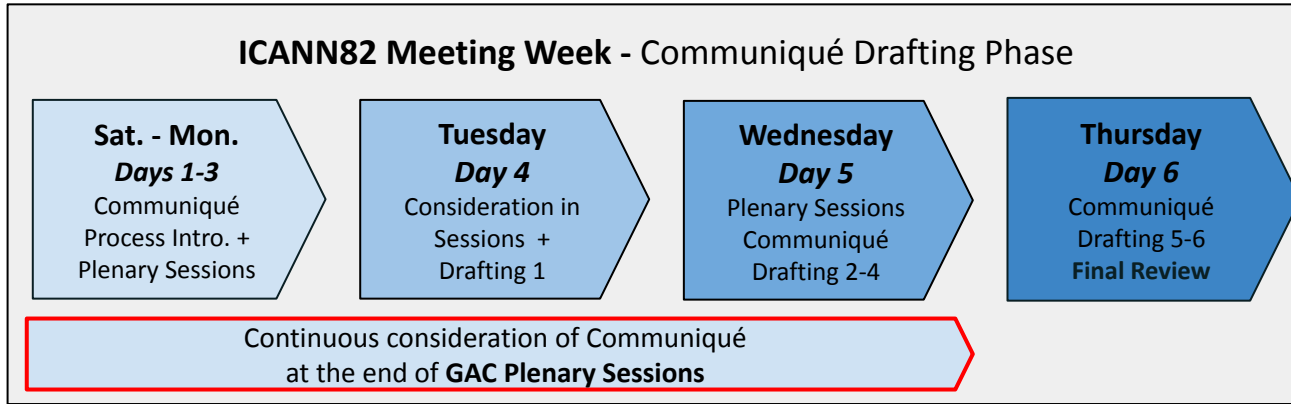

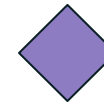
GAC Topic Leads and interested GAC Members invited to provide **Initial Communiqué Text**
