Objectives of a HLG

The GAC Strategic Plan includes the following priorities for 2025/2026 under Strategic Objective 1 (see [GAC Annual Plan 2025/2026](#)):

1.1. Stakeholder's Understanding of the Role of Governments: Enable all stakeholders to gain a clearer understanding of the role of governments in ICANN processes, including the GAC, leveraging the attendance and participation of senior levels of governments during **the next High Level Government Meeting (HLGM)**, and particularly its discussion of ICANN, the ICANN Multistakeholder model and their role in the wider Internet Governance ecosystem.

1.2. Discussion of Current Issues at Senior Levels - Next GAC HLGM: Identify the timing and location of the next GAC High level Government Meeting (HLGM).

1.3. Non-Represented Governments: To promote broader participation in the GAC, **seek to establish contacts with governments who are not yet, or not currently, represented on the GAC** with the collaboration of ICANN's Stakeholder and Government Engagement teams. Collaborate among current committee Members to encourage and support delegations who need to fill any delegate or representative vacancies."

Objectives of a HLGGM

GAC Guidelines for High Level Government Meetings (2016)

- **Reaffirm the critical role** that governments play in providing advice to the ICANN Board on public-policy issues as it relates to the secure and stable functioning of the Domain Name System.
- **Enable all parties to gain a clearer understanding** of the role of governments in ICANN processes, including the GAC and **Expose very senior administrative and elected officials** (Ministers, members of legislative bodies) **to ICANN** [...]
- **Discuss current public policy issues and challenges at very senior level.** [...]
- **Reach out to administrations and governments** who are not yet, or not currently, represented on the GAC or in other ICANN forums

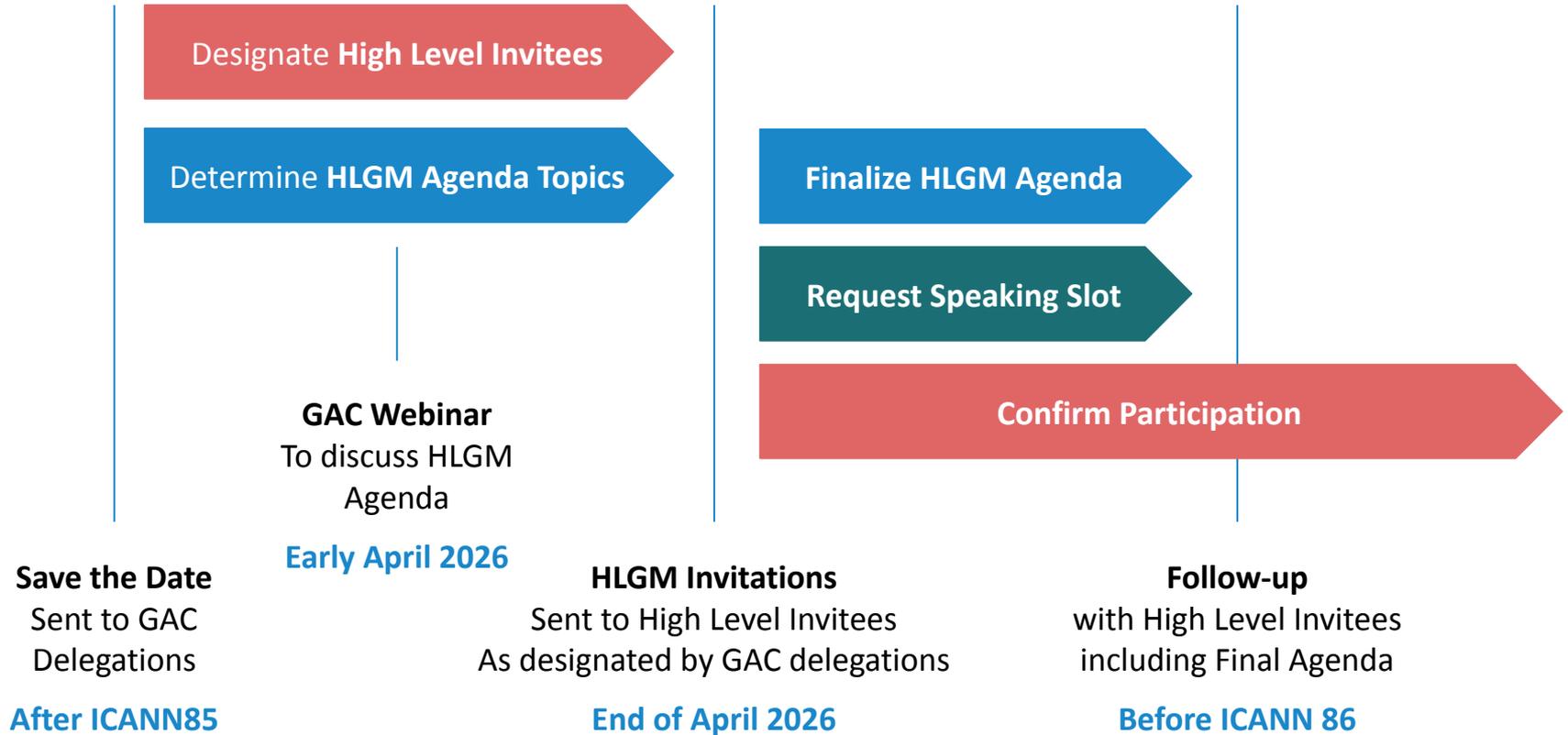
