- Established in part in response to community concerns
- With the community, consider the effectiveness of ICANN's Safeguards
- Focus on issues of importance to the community and consumer harms within the DNS
- Coordinating across ICANN Organization's teams



3. Current Safeguards and Compliance Tools

- ICANN's Current Safeguards
 - ICANN Articles of Incorporation
 - ICANN Bylaws
 - ICANN Agreements with Registrars and Registries
- Contractual Compliance Tools
 - Enforce the agreement and consensus policies
 - Conduct regular Compliance Audit
 - Regular Proactive Monitoring
