PICs/Global Public Interest

GAC Compilation of Individual Input on Subpro PDP WG recommendations (May 2020):

- GAC members mostly converged on noting that DNS abuse mitigation should be included in the SubPro PDP WG recommendations.
- A few GAC members mentioned the approach/effort to address DNS abuse should be holistic.
- Some GAC members mentioned importance of enforceability and enhancing dispute resolutions.

GAC Early Warnings/GAC Advice

GAC Compilation of Individual Input on Subpro PDP WG recommendations (May 2020):

- Most supported previous GAC positions supporting retention of the "will create a strong presumption for the ICANN Board that the application should not be approved".
- Converged on not limiting scope of GAC advice
- A few agreed on the need for alignment with ICANN Bylaws.

Please note:

GAC Consultation took place prior to updated PDP WG recommendation language, so may be to some extent outdated since substantive changes were made to draft recommendations

Community Based Applications

GAC Compilation of Individual Input on Subpro PDP WG recommendations (May 2020):

- Some GAC members agreed in principle with the draft recommendations.
- Some GAC members expressed concerns about the Community Priority Evaluation Process (CPE) specifically due to lack of clear definition of "community".
- GAC members converged on the need for further clarification of the CPE Process per <u>ICANN67 Communique</u> and recalled the GAC consensus positions from the <u>ICANN67 Communique</u> on CPEs.

Based on updated <u>GAC Scorecard</u>, topics of divergence/less alignment from GAC positions:

- Closed Generic TLDs
- Public Interest Commitments (PICs)/Global Public Interest
- GAC Early Warnings and GAC Advice
- Community Based Applications
- Auction Procedures
- Other topics?
