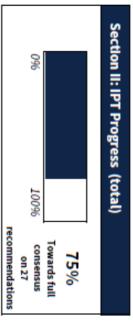

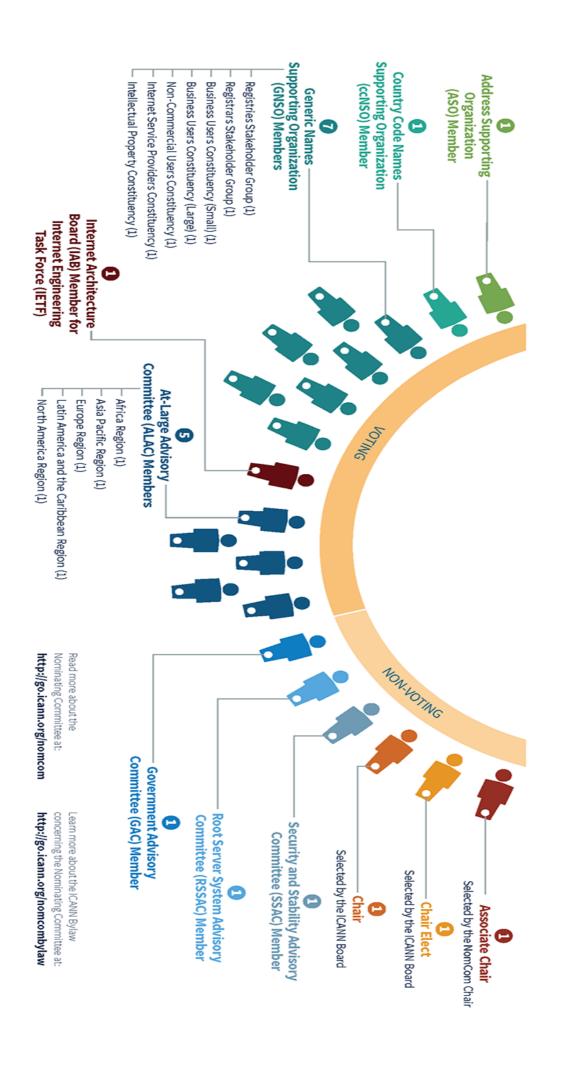

- Final report from independent examiner
- Staff report of public comments
- 0 OEC makes recommendation to ICANN Board about next steps, including approval of IE final report, NomCom IPT FAIIP.
- ICANN Board passes resolution
- 0 Subject to Board resolution, NomCom review implementation team is formed; begins drafting detailed implementation plan and starts implementation.
